PEAK SEASON SURCHARGE (PSS)

The Far East Shipping companies are charging a Peak Season Surcharge (PSS) from August 1st to November 15th 2007. The Peak Season Surcharge is charged on shipments from Asia (at this time excluding Japan). The Peak Season Surcharge is USD 135,-/TEU or USD 7,-/m3/1000 kg.

The Peak Season Surcharge may vary between shipping companies.

20' Container Premium in North PRC

Member Lines of the FEFC wish to announce that the 20' Container Premium will be increased from USD 150 to USD 250 for cargo loaded at the following North PRC Ports with effect from 1st June 2007: Yantai, Lianyungang, Dalian, Qingdao and Tianjin/Xingang

Heavy weight surcharge for traffic from Far East to Europe

Shipping Lines have informed about implementation of heavy weight surcharge for traffic from Far East to Europe including India, Bangladesh, Pakistan and Sri Lanka.

Surcharges varies between shipping lines, origin ports and weight classes from USD 150/20' to USD 700/20'. We reserve the right to changes of surcharges and those will be to valid tariff as per traffic area/shipping line.

Shipping Lines have also different implementations of weight restrictions concerning maximum payload for all container size. Furthermore for any misdeclaration penalty fee is effective.
